Preparing for the Test		Keyboard Shortcuts *To be used by Test Administrator only
Directions for Administration: ☐ Read the Administration Manual. ☐ Watch the Administration Training Video to familiarize yourself with the procedures for testing.	You will need a copy of the Administration Manual on the day of testing. It is also recommended to print the scripts ahead of time.	*Keep note of the following shortcuts which may have to be used during test administration. Consult with the Assessment Coordinator before providing any accommodations.
 Review Troubleshooting: Read through the troubleshooting section in the Administration Manual (Table 3.3 and 3.4). Familiarize yourself with issues that may occur during testing. 		Devices with External Keyboards: 1) "Alt" + "U" ("Option" + "U" on Apple devices) to pause the test.
 Student Access Codes: Have each students' unique access code needed to log into the test. Ensure the list is complete and all your students are on it. 	This should be printed out and ready to be distributed to each student before testing begins.	 2) "Alt" + "T" ("Option" + "T" for Apple devices) to disable the timer on the test. 3) "Alt" + "S" keys ("Option" + "S" for Apple devices) to save the responses.
Test Website: Have the URL for the test website available.	https://a2.mhs.com/ngat	4) "Alt" + "K" ("Option" + "K" for Apple devices) to display comic version of instructions.
Scratch Paper and Pencil: When testing with the Naglieri-Q, provide students with a few pieces of scratch paper and a pencil on the day of testing.	This should not be provided for the Naglieri-V and Naglieri-NV.	Tablets without External Keyboards: Find the keyboard icon at the top right-side of the screen. Tap and hold the icon for at least 5 seconds. When you lift your finger from the screen an onscreen keyboard will appear. 1) "U" to pause the test. 2) "T" to disable the timer on the test. 3) "S" to save the test. 4) "K" to display comic version of the instructions. Before giving the tablet back to students, ensure the keyboard is minimized.
