

Administration Options

In person while online:

Email a link to the rater which brings them directly to the assessment form. Practitioner or individual can complete the online form during an in-person session. Once the completed form is received, scores and reports can be generated.

Print the form for paper administration:



The practitioner prints the assessment form for the rater to bring to home, school, or the office. The rater will then fill out the form and return to the practitioner. The practitioner enters the information to return scores and generate reports.

Pay by report, not form

I'm a new online user. How do I get an MHS Online Assessment Center+ account? Does it cost anything to join? When you purchase online forms for the listed products, you will automatically get free access to the MHS Online Assessment Center+. A welcome email will be sent to you that includes a Getting Started Guide and your log-in credentials.

I am currently a user of the old Online Assessment Center. How do I switch to the new MHS Online Assessment Center+? In order to migrate from the old site to the new platform, there are steps outlined in a document—*Preparation Guide for Migration*—which is available through customer service or through your assessment consultant.

If I switch to the new site, will I lose all my data on the old site?

Not at all! When you're migrated over, all your old data is automatically transferred into the new platform.

What do you mean by a streamlined payment process?

Previously, you "used" a form when it was sent to a rater, whether they completed the assessment or not. Now you can send as many forms as you want; a use is only deducted when you generate a report.

Can I still generate a report from a paper form?

Of course! Simply log in to the Online Assessment Center+ and select Enter Responses from the Quick Tools list. You can then enter responses using your keyboard and immediately generate a report.
