TRAP-18 is designed for the assessment of individuals who may be at risk for lone actor terrorism, regardless of ideology or beliefs.



What is the TRAP-18?

The TRAP-18 is a structured professional judgement instrument for mental health, intelligence, law enforcement and security professionals assessing individuals who potentially may engage in lone-actor terrorism.



How is the TRAP-18 structured?

Focused on patterns of behaviour rather than distinctive variables, the TRAP-18 is two-fold in nature consisting of 8 proximal warning behaviours and 10 distal characteristics.



How is the TRAP-18 used?

TRAP-18 is intended to be used by mental health, intelligence, law enforcement and security professionals to manage operational data on a person of concern and prioritise cases based upon the presence or absence of warning behaviours and characteristics. It is not an actuarial instrument designed to specifically predict acts of lone actor terrorism.
